

KIWISAVER FIRST HOME WITHDRAWAL CHECKLIST

Download and print your KiwiSaver providers application form from their website.	
The application form will tell you the identification and proof of address documents you will need to arrange.	
If you are a 'second chance' homeowner you will need to obtain a letter from Housing New Zealand confirming this as part of your application documents.	
The identification and proof of address documents are required to be certified, and there will also be a statutory declaration which you will need to sign in front of a Justice of the Peace.

When you go to see your Justice of the Peace, please take with you your original documents and the copies of the same for them to certify.	
Once you have completed the above, let us know and forward your application to us.
